Re: Onsite Classes - Charisma University TCI

I considered the report of the Higher Education Board on your annual inspection. I also considered your request to extend your current remit beyond online classes to accommodate face to face classes or onsite physical classes.

Please note that after consideration, I am hereby granting your request to do the same. The delay in finalizing this decision, was due to the Immigration Ordinance coming into force and the necessary Department having the resources to process study visa and or study permits. As you may be aware there was no mechanism to provide students not resident in the TCI an opportunity to attend the TCI for Tertiary level study. Please also note, this is not an endorsement for Immigration purposes, and is just confirmation that your institution can provide 'on-site' classes.

Please note that you will be subject to an annual inspection to ensure that all the required standards are being followed.

You should ensure that students will be provided with certificates and other awards that are credible and can stand up to international, regional and local scrutiny. Please note that if this is not found to be so, and your school is found to be causing disrepute for the Turks and Caicos Islands, that the permission and any license granted to your institution will be revoked.
